I apologize about this limitation.

Anyway, as the values of commercial markets and the values of academy are different, I am still working on my book project and some of the images may still be able to be included in my book. I may continue to work with Chinese art colleagues to promote international clay artists during the next few years.

Working with Jingdezhen Municipal Government and the China National Academy of Arts (Beijing, China), the Chinese Ceramic Art Council USA is organizing Jingdezhen International Contemporary Ceramics Exhibition 2009. The exhibition will be held in Jingdezhen Ceramic Art Exhibition Hall in conjunction with the event of Jingdezhen International Ceramic Fair from Oct. 18th to Oct. 22nd, 2009.

Business is quite smooth and I would like to spend some time in my studio.

I have been going back and forth between the US and China every two months during the past decade to import clay tools, but this year, I have spent a lot of time in my studio. Where I was staying in Jingdezhen, there was no TV, no newspaper, and no internet (I visited an internet caf?for a few minutes each day). I like the simple life

style for working on my art. My new ceramic series will be magic eggs. These eggs are created using a slip cast of porcelain, and the cracks are hand carved for realism. I hope I will be able to get a few finished and include one piece in the show at Beijing Art Expo. I was invited for lectures on "the Main Stream of Fine Art and Contemporary Ceramics" in three schools: Wuxi Institute of Art and Technology in Yixing, China Academy of Fine Art in Hangzhou and Jingdezhen Institute of Ceramics.
